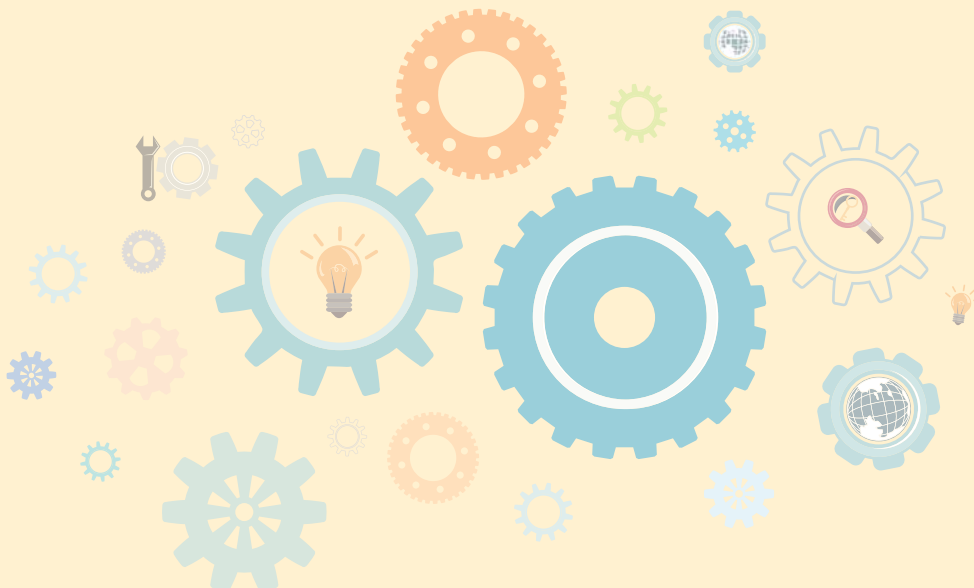

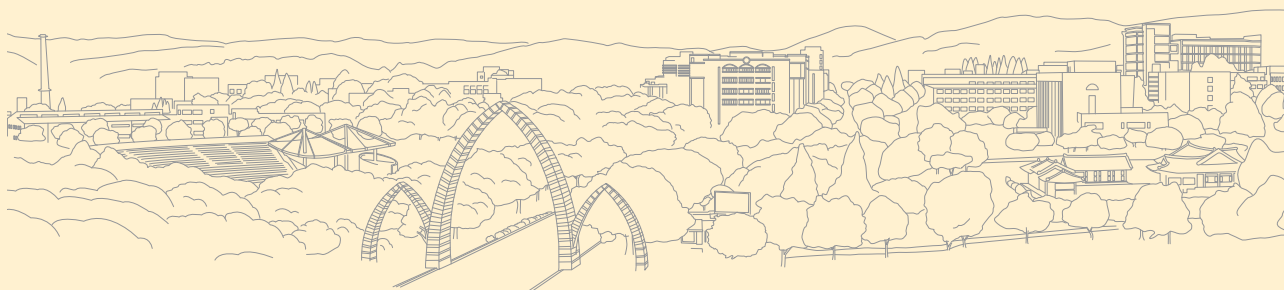

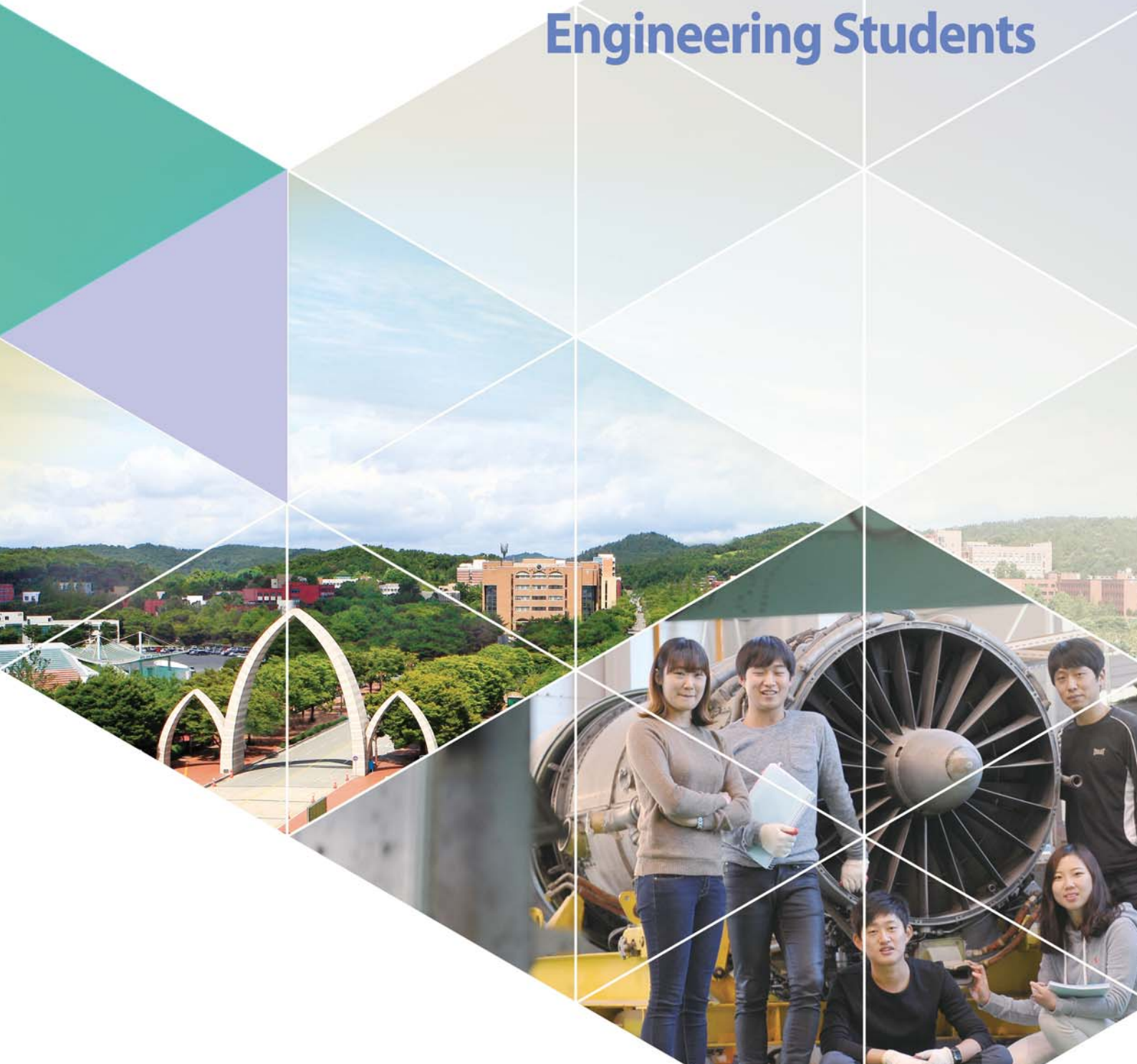

## II. Instruction

### 1. How GKS-ASEAN Program works

- a. A total number of participants : 24 → divided into 4 teams / a group of 6
  - 4 Korean students, as mentors, will be helping you out on a 24-hour basis during the whole program.
- b. Team meeting : either every morning before schedule starts or evening after schedule ends
  - A leader student will host a meeting to deliver important notice, check health condition, and share what members think about a daily schedule.
- c. There will be another 24 Korean students assisting you to implement research projects and helping you understand lectures.

### 2. Accommodation(Dormitory)

- a. Check-in : A smart key will be given to individual students for dormitory entry.
- b. Last call to return to dormitory is **10:00 p.m.** although it opens till 01:00 a.m.
  - \* Dormitory entry is closed from 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- c. No cooking, no smoking, and no drinking inside dormitory.
- d. Too much noise would disturb other residents.
- e. WiFi in the dormitory is available - you can have ID and password in the lobby.
- f. Check-out : Return the smart key to your team leader or Mr. Kim Hoe-Dong when you check out



### 3. Safety Guide

- a. If you get sick or injured, or do not feel well, immediately report to your team leader or staff members without hesitation.
- b. Do not get involved in any crime under any circumstances - this includes immigration issues.
- c. Do not go around at late night or insecure places alone.
- d. Report to your team leader or staff members if you are obliged to be separated from the group.
- e. Respect different culture, religion, gender, race, and manners

### 4. Individual Responsibilities

- a. Please engage in all the schedules and programs with your best efforts. If you do not fulfill this program in a good manner, you may not be able to receive a certificate of completion.
- b. You will be working on research projects by team, and present the research results at the NIIED on August 11, 2016 (further information will be released at the orientation of the NIIED on July 8, 2016)
- c. Survey : Complete and return a questionnaire when asked.

### 5. Transportation from/to the Incheon Int'l Airport

- a. Pick-up
  - When: from 07:00 a.m. on July 4
  - Where: in front of exit gate No. 9 of 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Airport
- b. Send-off
  - When to depart: 11:00 a.m. on August 12
    - \* If you have to leave earlier than this schedule on August 12, please discuss with the coordinator.
    - \* If you leave other than August 12, you are on your own to move to the airport.
  - From where: the NIIED (Seongnam City)

### 6. Important Notes

- a. Insurance : Your health insurance will be covered by GNU, but **please note that you will be responsible for some of hospital expenses** although most of the expenses will be covered by the insurance company.
- b. GKS-ASEAN Program covers a round-trip flight ticket(between Incheon Int'l Airport and an international airport in your home country), room and board, tuition, expenses for cultural experiences, and transportation in Korea during the program. After checking out on August 12, you should be responsible for all the expenses on you own.
- c. Food
  - Muslim-only meals available at dormitory cafeteria (88meals)
  - Other meals will be mostly buffet style or include many of side dishes, so you can carefully choose what you eat on the table.

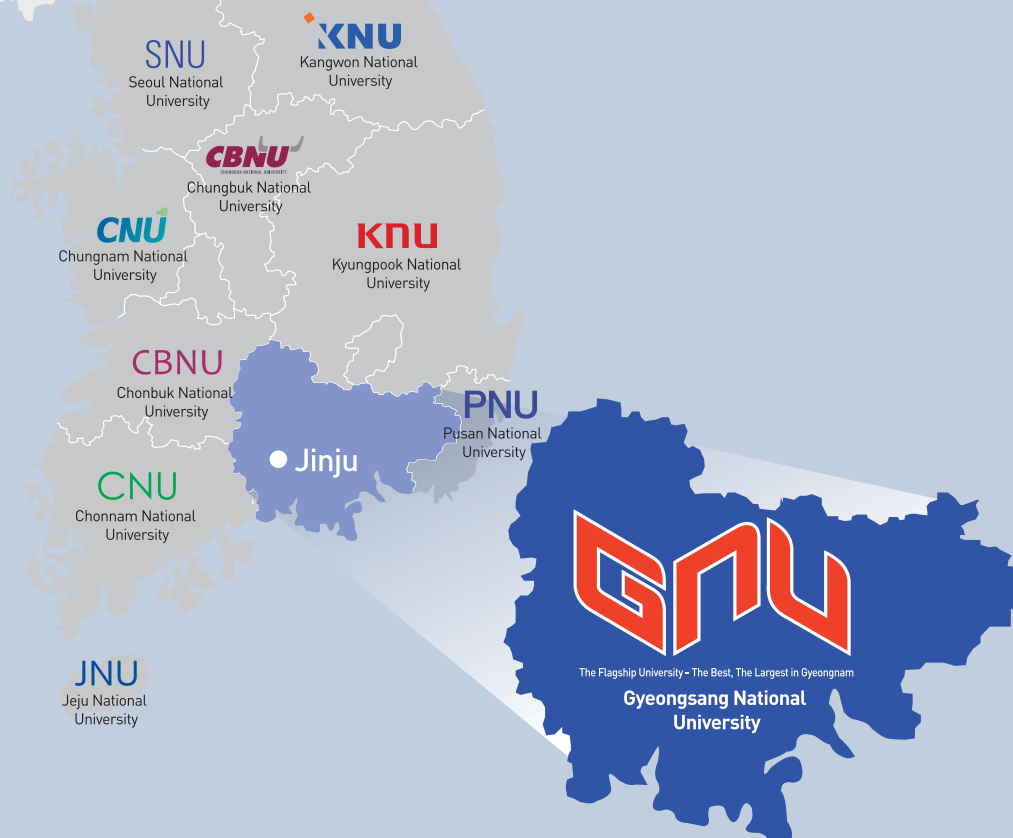
